

Lincoln Academy Case Study

Lincoln Academy is a K-9 Charter School located in Pleasant Grove, Utah. 575 students attend the school. It was established in 2005 with the mission of inspiring children to love learning and to empower them to explore and achieve their individual potential.



Lincoln Academy has mixed environment of PCs, two Apple Mac computer labs and several Apple Macbook wireless laptop carts. Before implementing LanSchool, the teachers used Apple Remote Desktop (ARD) for their classroom management solution.

ARD worked well for their desktop management needs, but fell short when the teachers wanted to perform important classroom management features such as blocking applications and the Internet. They attempted to modify the settings on their filter, but that was not flexible enough for different lessons and classes. ARD also did not work with their PCs.



After implementing LanSchool, the teachers at Lincoln became more effective because they monitor and keep the students on task.
