Before LanSchool we used open source products such as WinVNC and iTALC. While these products worked on some level, they tended to be “buggy” and lacked the necessary features to have consistent control of our student computer lab. When a teacher is working in front of a group of students, it is important that technology be transparent and “just work”. LanSchool is such a product.

We chose LanSchool because it had the best combination of price (important for a public school budget) and features. Once we started using it, we were highly impressed with its stability, ease of use, and feature set. Over the years, the program has gotten better and better with each new version.

The clean simple blanking of student screens is the most often used feature. Broadcasting the teacher screen to all students, and broadcasting a student screen to other students is also important. Beyond that, we appreciate the web URL history and web blocking capabilities.

Recently, we have become very impressed with the ability to control multiple workstations at the same time. We have installed Windows Steady State so the machines stay “clean” when restarted, and having LanSchool’s ability to log the administrator into ALL machines at the same time saves a lot of time during lab maintenance periods.

LanSchool has the best technical support I have experienced with a software product. Once when I had a problem, a LanSchool support person offered to fly out to my school and troubleshoot the problem in person. I was stunned.
